



Data Collection Process

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Why we collect data ?

Collecting and disseminating information on the Core Regional Transport Network is one of the major activities of the SEETO. Collecting up-to-date information is essential for planning and reviewing the development of the Core Network, monitoring the implementation of the multi annual plan, facilitation of reforms, studies and analysis, reporting and publicity.



Data collection process - steps

- SEETO defined a Data Collection Action Plan,
- Plan is a part of SEETO Action Plan,
- Collection through established procedures,
- SEETO organizing training and providing tools for the data collection process,
- Day to day communication with NC.



Data collection process - stakeholders

- the National Coordinators,
- the key data providers in the various organizations which are acquiring information, and
- SEETO team.



Data collection process - data

Information is collected about:

- Infrastructure and traffic,
- Priority projects,
- Soft (horizontal) measures,
- Road safety,
- Waiting times on border crossings, and
- Intermodality.

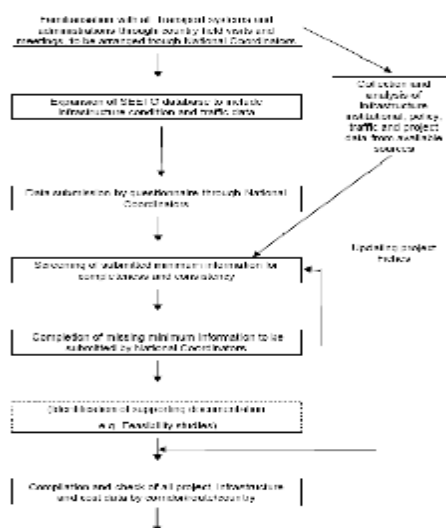


MAP 2009-13 Activities timetable

- 22 September - MAP 2009-13 second draft

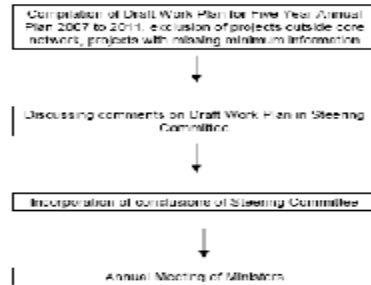


Data collection chart
