## Successful stories

- Multimodal Corridor Vc – Road

In 2007 Bosnia and Herzegovina have secured financing for priority list project Reconstruction of Seslije – Samac (BIHRD006), length 13 km, total cost 20 M€.

- Multimodal Corridor X - Road

During 2008 completion of works on Ostruznica – Orlovaca section (priority project list SERRD17.3) is planned.

- Route 7 - Road

Albania have secured financing for three sections of road Milot-Morine (Priority list project ALBRD00013), namely Milot-Rreshen (36 M€), Rreshen-Kalimash (500 M€) and Kalimash-Morine (120 M€). Construction works on some sections has been started.

The priority list for MAP 2009-2013 comprises 24 project groups (a group being a number of projects related to the same Corridor or Route) with 40 individual projects.
