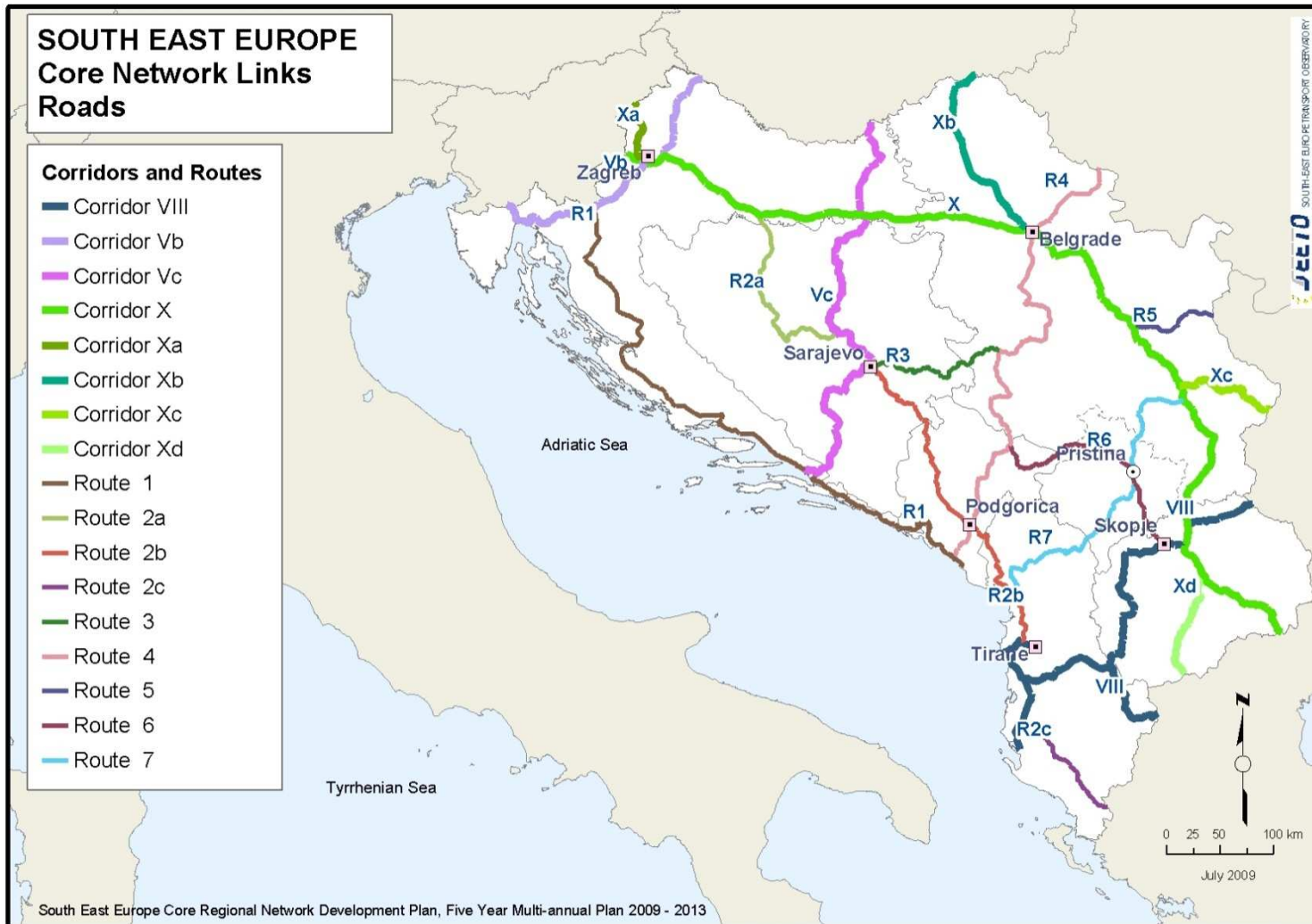

SEETO Mission

SEETO Mission is to facilitate the programming and implementation of the MoU provisions foreseen to improve and modernize the Core Network for social and economic development.

SEETO mandate also includes cooperation and exchange of the comprehensive information with the relevant international agencies and financial institutions active in the South East Europe region and with the relevant Secretariats of the Pan-European corridors, in order to achieve maximum compatibility between development strategies.

SEETO Tasks

The main objective of SEETO is to support the Steering Committee in the implementation of the MoU which promotes cooperation in the development of South East Europe regional transport.

SEETO specific objectives are:

- Collecting data on the Core Regional Transport Network and maintaining and updating an information system;
- Prepare and regularly update a 5 year rolling Multi-Annual Work Plan in order to assist for strengthening regional planning capacity in transport;
- To provide a programme of soft measures which will encourage and harmonize reforms in transport sector.
