Introduction

- Regional Transport Organization established by Memorandum of Understanding for the development of the SEE Core Regional Transport Network signed 11th June 2004
- 5 Annual Ministerial Meetings
- 21 Steering Committee Meetings
- 9 National Coordinator Meetings



SEETO Goals

- Support the implementation of the MoU which promotes development of the Core Network;
- Collect data on the Core Network and maintain an information system;
- Prepare a 5 year rolling Multi-Annual Work Plan for the development of the Core Network and for the implementation of projects and priorities on the Core Regional Transport Network;
- Provide assistance for development of regional soft measures and strengthening regional planning capacity in transport.

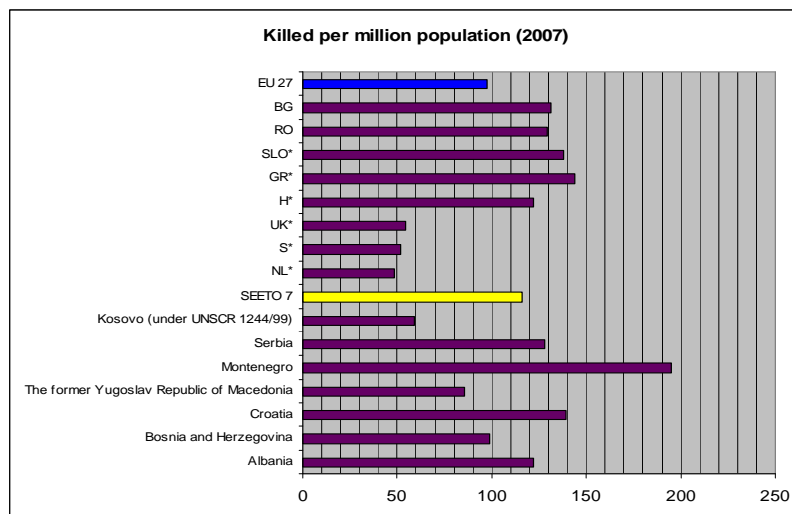


Road Safety in South East Europe

- Public awareness is low.

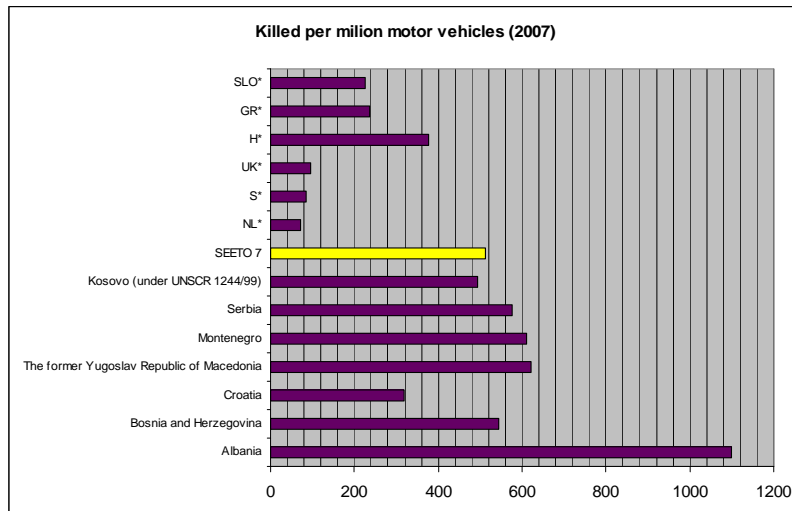


Road Safety indicators (I)
