Harmonisation of definitions and use of terms in order to facilitate communication:

- between IMS/ABs
- between IMS/ABs and their international customers

Focus: terminological aspects of NSS

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Corridor Statements – the idea

Only Corridor Brochures exist so far

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The harmonisation pyramid

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Aligned description of products and services

- Generate an overview over the IMS products and services.
- Generate aligned descriptions of IMS' and RNE's products + services
- Hand over a document for an adaptation of the NS CS

Simplification and transparency of charging
