Aim of the meeting :

The **SEETO Working Group on Road Safety** formed on a temporary basis according to paragraph 9 of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on the development of the South East Europe Core Regional Transport Network (SEETO) is playing the main role in the road safety issues in the region. Among other duties the working group is in charge as well to: recommend procedures to implement road safety audit regulations and Regional Safety Audit Agreement, gives opinion on road safety audit manual and monitor implementation of Road Safety Audit and Safety Inspection is SEETO Participants.

The overall objective is thus to help close the gap between the Regional Participants and the EU with regards to road safety with the vision to reach the same level of road safety and establish the positive trends in continuous decline of number of fatalities and injuries as is the case in EU.

The specific objective of the training programme is to introduce road safety audits to key persons in the SEETO Regional Participants to assist them to introduce road safety in their country.

The aim of the training is to introduce the ***Regional Participants to basic road safety principles and Road Safety Audits (RSA) principles*** to key persons in the SEETO Regional Participants to assist them to introduce road safety audits in their country to help improve road safety.
